

Wombat Mange Treatment

A Wombat with mange lives in our area and was last seen in the nature corridor adjacent to the roundabout.

The Wombat is being treated by volunteers using a treatment that is applied to its skin directly or remotely via a burrow flap device.

If you see this Wombat please stay away from it and contact Wires local wildlife volunteer as detailed below.

WARNING: Do not touch this wombat or the burrow device.
The burrow device contains Cydectin Pour-On

Poisonous if swallowed: Will irritate eyes and skin. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Do not inhale. May irritate the nose and throat.
